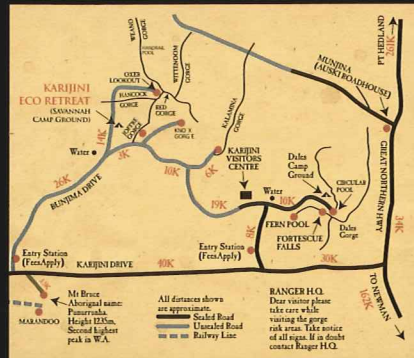

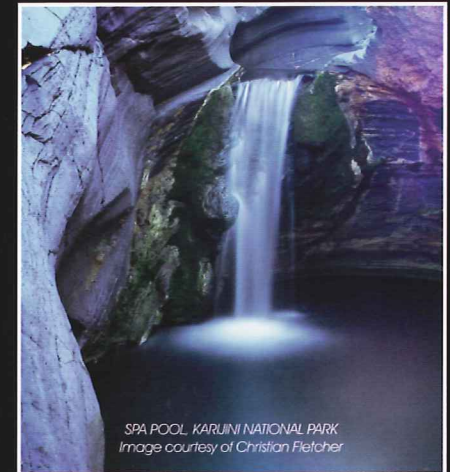

Department of Environment and Conservation

Karijini Eco Retreat operates within Karijini National Park in collaboration with the Department of Environment and Conservation and the Traditional Owners to contribute to the management of the environmental, geographical and cultural values of this world class park. A portion of your tarriff goes towards the management and conservation of the park for your next visit and future generations.

### National Park Passes and Entry Fees

Visitor fees apply to some Western Australian national parks including Karijini National Park. You may wish to pre-purchase these through your local tourist centre or the relevant governing body – the Department of Environment and Conservation (DEC) see [www.dec.wa.gov.au](http://www.dec.wa.gov.au). The fees collected are invested in the parks to improve facilities for visitors. Passes are available at Karijini Eco Retreat but are not included in any rates.

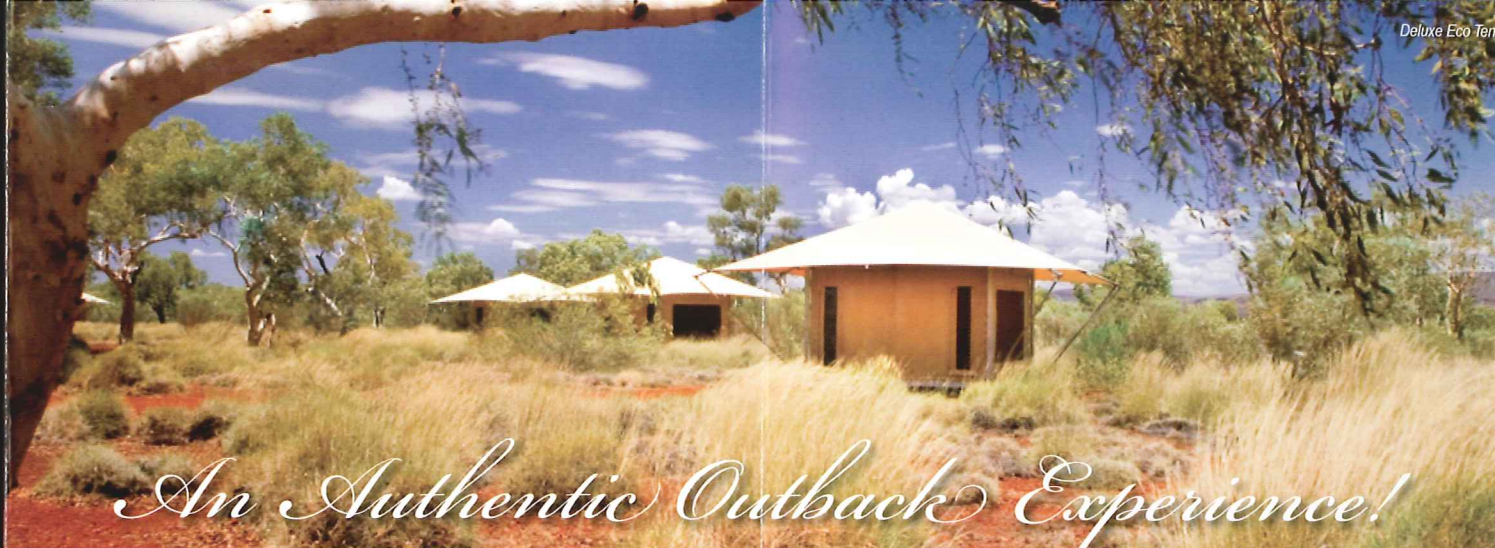

Karijini Eco Retreat is 100% owned by the Gumala Aboriginal Corporation (GAC) representing the collective interests of the Traditional Owners.

Gumala represents the interests of the Niapiali, Bunjima and Innawonga Peoples of the Pilbara region of Western Australia. Gumala is the Aboriginal word in the Bunjima Language meaning "all together".

Gumala Enterprises Pty Ltd (GEPL) being the commercial arm of GAC have the responsibility of overseeing the operation of the Retreat.

Campsites (non-powered) are provided for the traditional campers who prefer to pitch their own tent or bring their own caravan or camper. All campsite guests are welcome to make full use of the restaurant, bar and kiosk or join one of the exciting adventure tours available for purchase from the tour desk.

## - Karijini National Park -

1400kms north of Perth in the spectacular Pilbara region lies the iconic Karijini National Park – the second largest in WA. The Park boasts breathtaking scenery from spinifex covered plains to contrasting hues of red ochre and striking blues in sheer sided chasms and cavernous gorges.
