MID & LOW SEASONS: 1st NOVEMBER 2017 to 29th MARCH 2018

During the above dates The Karijini Eco Retreat operates in 'Low Season' and therefore has limited availability in the Eco tents for those wishing to visit during this period.

The nightly rate for Deluxe Eco Tents with ensuite is **\$189.00 per couple** for the months of December to February inclusive and **\$229.00** for the months of November and March. Rates include continental breakfast. This represents a significant saving when compared to our high season rate (No further discounts apply). A small number of tents suitable for families are available (sleeping 3 or 4 people – additional bed is a single or bunk bed) and extra guests are charged \$75 per person per night (first child up to 12 years old stays free when sharing with 2 adults).

Dorm Eco Cabins sleeping up to 4 people with shared ablutions cost **\$159.00** per night for the months of December to February inclusive and **\$179.00** for the months of November and March. Rates include continental breakfast.

Campgrounds will remain open (subject to weather conditions) at a rate of **\$20.00** per adult per night for an unpowered site. (Children up to 12 years old stay free when travelling with an adult).

PLEASE TAKE INTO ACCOUNT THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS AND ADVICE BEFORE BOOKING:

- Temperatures at Karijini during this period can reach in excess of 40 degrees Celsius on a daily basis
- Our accommodations are **NOT** air-conditioned. Deluxe Eco Tents and Dorm Eco Cabins have a fan/natural ventilation only
- The Alfresco restaurant will operate during this time, opening for breakfast, lunch & dinner. A selection of menu items will be available during this time (subject to availability) and guests will be asked to pre-order meals on a daily basis
- As places are limited, dinner must be booked in advance
- Please call Reception on (08) 9189 8013 to reserve your table and meals
- Guest barbecue facilities will also be available on site
- Reception opening hours will be 7am – 10am, & 12pm – 7.30pm
- Bar and kiosk opening times will coincide with Reception hours
- Supplies such as ice creams, snacks, ice for your eski and beverages will be subject to availability
- We strongly advise that guests arrive in either 4WD or AWD vehicles (there are approximately 3km of unsealed road to the Eco Retreat Reception when approaching via the western access road)
- If renting your vehicle please check requirements/restrictions directly with them
- We highly recommend the use of insect repellent
- There will be no Tour Operator services at the Karijini Eco Retreat or in the National Park during this period
- For your own convenience and safety it is advisable that you check all weather and road conditions before your arrival and (if visiting the gorges) please ensure

- that in the event of adverse weather conditions you take appropriate steps to leave the gorges immediately
- Department of Parks & Wildlife (DPAW) reserves the right to close roads within the National Park for safety reasons and/or due to adverse weather conditions
 - Closure of gorges does not mean closure of the park and Eco Retreat – please **ALWAYS** check directly with our team to avoid cancellation charges
